

Video Content Distribution Policy

1. The following individuals and/or organizations are entitled to 1 (one) complimentary copy of any Connecticut Network (hereinafter, “the network”) program:
 - a. Serving members of the Connecticut State House of Representatives and State Senate.
 - b. Serving constitutional officers of the executive branch. (Governor, Lieutenant Governor, etc.)
 - c. Connecticut State Agencies. (see Schedule A)
 - d. Serving members of committees, commissions, and offices established by the state. (see Schedule A)
 - e. Serving constitutional officers of the judicial branch. (Judges, Supreme Court Justices, etc.)
2. Regular pricing applies to any additional copies of the same program ordered by entities described in section (1).
3. Regular pricing applies to all other individuals and organizations not specifically identified in section (1).
4. Unless otherwise specified, prices, tax, and shipping charges quoted orally or in writing by Network staff assume the use of a single DVD. Additional charges may apply for longer programs that must be recorded on multiple DVDs.
5. Content is for private use only; the network reserves all rights to all content.
6. Content may not be reposted, rebroadcast or re-used in its entirety in any application without the express written consent of the network. Exceptions not requiring authorizations include:
 - a. Press releases, press kits or related public information material.
 - b. Selected educational content, as designated.

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7. No excerpts of media may be edited or incorporated into other productions without the express written consent of the network. Exceptions not requiring authorizations include:
 - a. Press releases, press kits or related public information material.
 - b. Selected educational content, as designated.
8. Use of any media in the context of political advertising or communication is expressly forbidden.
